

## DEAR PARENT/GUARDIAN,

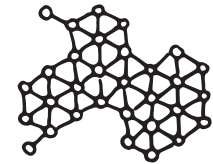
At Google, we think about what's next. We aim to make the future world a better place by building technology, investing in initiatives, and making the Internet more accessible for everyone.

### HOW TO ENTER

1. Download and print the entry form at [google.com/doodle4google](https://google.com/doodle4google) or ask your student's teacher for an entry form.
2. On the entry form, have artists create their doodles using any material they want, write their 50-word statement, and sign your student's form.
3. Students can draw the doodle on another sheet of paper, take a digital photo or scan the doodle and tape it to the official entry form. Just be sure that the tape is clear and the doodle fits above the information on the bottom of the entry form.
4. Entry forms can be submitted digitally at [google.com/doodle4google](https://google.com/doodle4google) as a .jpg or .png file. Entry forms can also be submitted by mail. Mailed submissions must be postmarked by December 2, 2016 and received seven days from the postmark deadline at the below addresses:
