You will be assessed on your ability to:

- label angles as acute or obtuse
- estimate and measure angles
- describe geometric solids using the words vertex, base, face, edge, congruent

- solve multi-digit addition and subtraction problems
- determine the median, mode, minimum, maximum, and range for a set of data
- solve multi-digit multiplication and division problems
- solve word problems and show the summary and number models
- understand factors and multiples
- insert parentheses to make a number sentence true
- find the solution of an open number sentence
- understand basic fractions
- write a fraction as a decimal and as a percent
