Students will be assessed on their ability to:

- solve division number stories and interpret remainders
- write number models with an unknown and write summary number models
- divide multi-digit numbers using a reliable algorithm
- multiply multi-digit numbers and compare them
- write remainders as fractions
- classify and measure angles as acute, right, obtuse, or reflex
- plot and label points on a coordinate grid
- insert parentheses to make a true number sentence
- round numbers
